


DIY BIRD-FRIENDLY WINDOW DECALS



Nearly one billion birds die each year in the United States as a result of colliding into windows. Birds do not perceive reflections in glass as a barrier, so it is helpful to put decals, vertical blinds, or to draw vertical lines on windows so that birds can know that the glass is a solid surface.

Make your windows bird-friendly by creating your own window decals!



Supplies:

Puffy paint Plastic surface (recycled plastic containers work great!)




Step 1:

On a flat plastic surface create, your designs! Thickly apply the paint for best success, like you see in the photo above. Thinly made designs tend to tear more easily when peeled from the plastic.

Step 2:

Let the design completely dry for at least 24 hours. Depending on the design's size and thickness, it may need longer to completely dry.



Step 3:

Peel the design from the plastic surface and apply it to the inside of your window! Enjoy your beautiful, bird-friendly creation.
